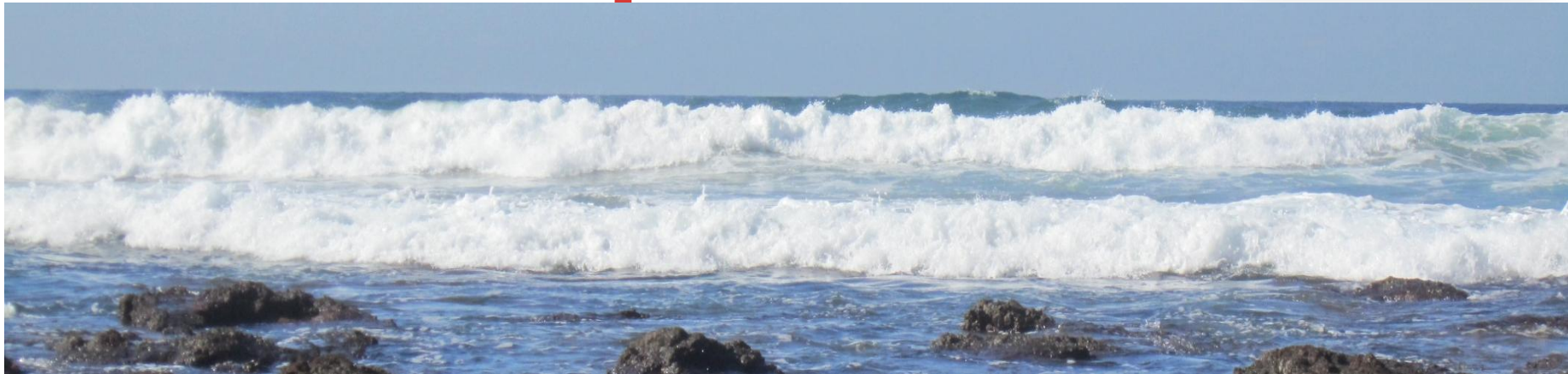
They forget about Easter.

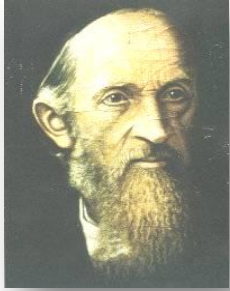
